Diaper Bag Project

\$603.56 was collected for our diaper bag project. With this amount we were able to fill eleven diaper bags and deliver them to HALO for new mothers who may not have the support to get the things needed to get started with a precious little baby. Each bag contained 6 pairs of socks, 2 bibs, 2 hats, several long sleeve onesies, several short sleeve onesies, 2 footed sleepers, 4 washcloths, 2 receiving blankets, 4 burps cloths, a book, 88 diapers, and a card with a note of encouragement for the new mother and an invitation to visit our church with her child. Celeste Savage, at HALO, was very pleased to accept the bags and said she would see that they were distributed to new mothers.
