St John's is experiencing some financial strain currently and we need your assistance, please. To meet our budget, we need an average Sunday offering of around \$2300 and currently ours totals \$1600 per week on average. We are not in serious trouble, as we do have trustee funds and currently, we receive about \$24,000.00 per year from these funds. To date we have had to request \$10,000 – almost half of the year's expected drawings - and this is only March. This message is to make you aware and to request that you consider additional tithings or gifts to St. John's. We make every effort to keep expenses to a bare minimum, however, all costs are increasing. Our insurance has been one area of increase and we will be investigating and pricing this expense. The Board is also considering selling one of the excess parking lots we have at the end of Main Street towards South Division Street as a possible source of funds. We will experience some decrease in expenses when we lose Pastor Karen, as her successor will be considered part time. (Not that we are looking forward to loosing Pastor Karen because we are not!) We wanted to make all aware that we are looking to decrease expenses whenever possible and possibly free up funds through sale of unused property if that is feasible. If you would, please keep this in mind as you budget your offerings for our church.
